

Head Coach Jeff Gordon

Coach Jeff Gordon enters his 29th year of coaching at Sunny Hills HS. Jeff began his coaching career with the Brea-Olinda HS Men's soccer team and stayed there 4 years before coming to SHHS in 1990. Jeff is entering his 33rd consecutive high-school soccer season. Coach Gordon became Head Coach in 1993 with the retirement of his father, Kenn Gordon. The Lancers have won 18 Freeway League Championships, 9 League runner-up's, 27 CIF appearances, 2 CIF Titles, 3 CIF Finalists, 4 Semi-Finalists, 8 CIF Quarter-Finalists in his 28 seasons at SHHS. In 2018, the Lady Lancers qualified for the State Regionals for the first time and made it all the way to State Regional Finals. Jeff has coached 4 CIF Players of the year, 2 Orange County Players of the Year, and 13 Freeway League MVP's. 120 of his players have made All-League, 61 have been selected All-CIF, and over 50 have went on to play college soccer.

As a player, Jeff played four seasons at Brea-Olinda HS and led his team to the 1986 CIF Championship scoring the clinching goal. He was named Orange League MVP, 1st Team All- CIF & 1st Team All-County (OC Register & LA Times). His 14 goals and 24 assists led the team. His 24 assists set a school single season record that lasted for 21 years. Jeff went on to play two seasons at Fullerton College where he was team captain, All- Conference and All American.

Jeff coached at Cypress College for six seasons helping them to the 2004 State Championship and 5 Conference titles. Jeff also coached in the AC Brea Club for seven years and served as technical director for the last four.

Erick was a four-year Varsity starter at Bell Gardens HS. He scored the game winning goals to lead his team to the 1991 CIF title and was named 1991 CIF Player of the year. *Erick went onto play at Chapman College where he was selected All-American and led his team to the National Final Four.*

Erick has an impressive coaching resume. He has coached at Fullerton College, Saddleback College, Bell Gardens HS and currently is Head Coach for the Cypress College Women's soccer team. He has been a part of 5 CIF or State Championship teams.

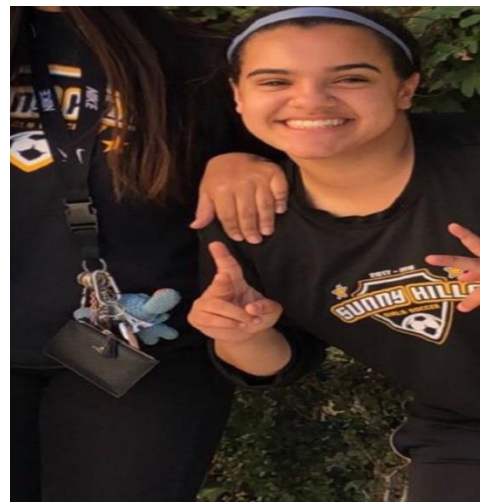

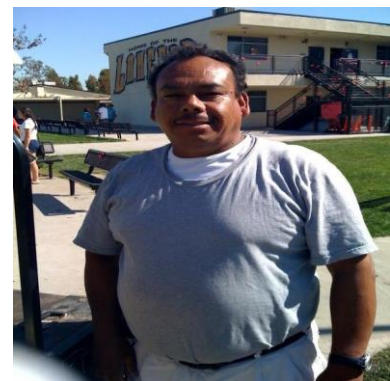

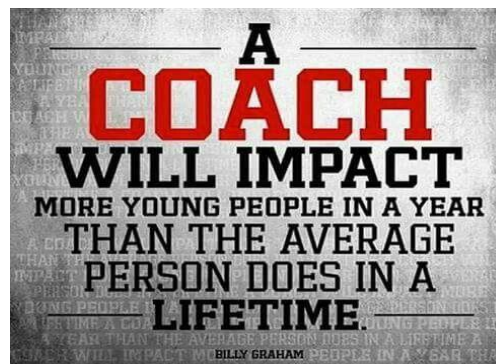
